Dayle Bayliss was employed directly by the client of this Grade I Listed Building in London to project manage & supervise the restoration and conservation of the historic fabric. Through years of build up of dirt and dust the decorative surfaces were showing many signs of deterioration, with details to the scagliola and plaster work requiring stabilisation and repair.

The project was undertaken with specialist paint conservators, whilst the building was still in use.

The repairs were phased to allow users of the building to enjoy the space with minimal disruption.

The approach was light touch with the aim to conserve as much of the historic fabric. The project was also monitored by English Heritage who praised the approach undertaken by the paint and plaster conservators. The result was the reinstatement of the space to its former glory and a maintenance programme to slow down the process of decay.
